Recipe of the Month

Play-dough Recipe

Ingredients

2 Cups flour
 2 Tablespoons vegetable oil
 1/2 Cup salt
 2 Tablespoons of cream of tartar
 1 1/2 Cups boiling water
 Food coloring (optional)

Directions

Mix the flour, salt, cream of tartar and oil in a large mixing bowl.

Add the food coloring to the boiling water then into the dry ingredients.

Stir continuously until it becomes sticky, combined dough.

Knead it vigorously for a couple of minutes until stickiness has gone. ****This is the most important part of the process, so keep at it until it's the perfect consistency!****

If it remains a little sticky then add a touch more flour until just right.
